1. NJ Code Changes

- A. Please be aware that on September 21, 2015 the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) adopted revised energy codes as follows:
 - i. International Energy Conservation Code/2015 (Residential)
 - ii. ASHRAE 90.1-2013 (Commercial)
- B. A grace period of six (6) months is provided for permit applications submitted to DCA.

2. Documents & Tools: Partner Portal

- A. P4P EB: Weather data through 1-1-16
- B. P4P EB: ERP Tables & Word doc v4.3
 - i. *Utility Info tab:* Incorporated dropdowns to fill in utility rate structures. Note this is required for ICP Pilot participants, optional for all others.
 - ii. *Electric Totals tab and Utility Use Summary tab:* Added columns to track monthly kW
 - iii. *General Project Information tab:* Project Team table now includes space for Energy Modeler and their associated credentials
 - iv. Lighting Tab:
 - Fixture dropdown modified into two columns: Technology Type and Fixture/Lamp Description. This should make it much easier to narrow down inputs compared to the long list that was previously there.
 - Note that some LED and CFL screw ins, and select HIDs will no longer have default wattages. Actual watts per fixture should be entered, although columns L & Y will highlight yellow if wattage input is outside of normal range.
 - Updated Lighting Support spreadsheet has also been posted.






- v. Measure Simulation Tab:
 - For TRACE projects only: First table modified to now include 'Lighting-Unconditioned' in the Lighting end use category. 'Receptacles-Unconditioned' now included in Plug Load end use.
 - For TRACE projects only: Second table modified Btu/kWh conversion from 0.003412 to 0.003413 to now align with TRACE reporting.
 - Third table, added "Cost Source" dropdown to Column V (similar to that in P4P NC).
- C. Please ensure you are using the latest version of all documents from the partner portal vs. copies previously savings to your computers/networks.

3. P4P-ICP Pilot

Q: The derating guidelines seem like they would limit calibration, yes?

A: Perhaps, but there are many ways to achieve calibration. Per the Guidelines, unknown or variable parameters are better candidates to adjust in order to calibrate the model (e.g. setpoints, metrics not directly associated with a measure, etc.).

- iv. Sub-consultants must CC partner of record on all email correspondence.
- v. For bulk submittals (e.g. ESIP projects) we will be reaching out to the partner following application approval to advise on how best proceed with ERP submittals.
