TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **Assignment** – The Participating Customer may assign Program Incentive payments to a specified vendor.
- **Eligibility Process** – A customer, or an agent (contractor/vendor) authorized by an Applicant, must submit a properly completed Pre-Qualification application package. A complete application package should include the application completed and signed in addition to all information requested. Program Manager will review the application package to determine if all information is complete. In the event the application is not complete or additional information is needed to complete the application, the Program Manager will request this information from the primary point of contact as listed by the entity. To qualify, eligible entities must be an accredited college or university per https://www.nj.gov/highereducation/colleges/schools_sector.shtml and have a multi-building campus served by New Jersey Utilities.
- **Prevailing Wage Law:** By submitting an application, or accepting program incentives, applicant agrees to adhere to New Jersey Prevailing Wage requirements, as applicable. For the avoidance of doubt, the signatories of the present Application Form have similarly agreed.
- **Endorsement** – The Program Manager and Administrator do not endorse, support, or recommend any particular manufacturer, product or system design in promoting this Program.
- **Decarbonization Measures** – Any device eligible to receive a Program Incentive payment through the NJ Clean Energy Higher Education Decarbonization Pilot Program.
- **Entity** - Defined as (1) Public: having distinct and separate budgetary authority; (2) Public Schools: having distinct and separate budgetary authority;(3) Private: Non-residential companies including all related subsidiaries and affiliates regardless of separate EIN numbers or locations within New Jersey. Consistent with DOCKET NO. EOO7030203. Hospitals are not an eligible entity for LEUP participation.
- **Limitation of Liability** – By virtue of participating in this Program, Participating Customers agree to waive any and all claims or damages against the Program Manager, the Program Administrator, and the Sponsor (collectively, Program Parties), except the receipt of the Program Incentive. Participating Customers agree that the Program Parties' liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified. Under no

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circumstances shall the Program Parties or any of their representatives or subcontractors, be liable for any lost profits, special, punitive, consequential, or incidental damages or for any other damages or claims connected with or resulting from participation in this Program. Further, any liability attributed to the Program Parties under this Program shall be individual, and not joint and/or several.

- **Program Manager** – TRC.
- **New Jersey Utilities** – The regulated electric and/or gas utilities in the State of New Jersey. They are: Atlantic City Electric, Jersey Central Power & Light, Rockland Electric Company, New Jersey Natural Gas, Elizabethtown Gas, PSE&G, and South Jersey Gas.
- **Participating Customers** – Also referred to as Applicants. Those accredited colleges or universities with multi-building campuses who are non-residential electric and/or gas service customers of the New Jersey Utilities and participate in this Program.
- **Participating Customer's Certification** – Participating Customer certifies that he/she will purchase and install the equipment listed in their forthcoming Decarbonization Plan at their defined New Jersey location. Participating Customer agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the Program and equipment requirements listed in the application.
- **Program** – The Higher Education Decarbonization Pilot Program and Large Energy Users Program, which are part of New Jersey's Clean Energy Plan sponsored by the Sponsor.
- **Program Offer** – Program Incentives are available to accredited colleges and universities who are non-residential retail electric and/or gas service customers of the New Jersey Utilities identified above.
- **Tax Liability** – The Program Parties will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on any Participating Customer as a result of the payment of Program Incentives. All Participating Customers must supply their Federal Tax Identification number or social security number to the Program Manager on the application form in order to receive a Program Incentive. In addition, Participating Customers must also provide a Tax Clearance Form (Business Assistance or Incentive Clearance Certificate) that is dated within 180 days of equipment installation.
- **Termination** – Sponsor reserves the right to extend, modify (this includes modification of Program Incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice. Incentives/Requirements subject to change.
- **Warranties** – THE PROGRAM PARTIES DO NOT WARRANT THE PERFORMANCE OF INSTALLED EQUIPMENT, AND/OR SERVICES RENDERED AS PART OF THIS PROGRAM, EITHER EXPRESSLY OR IMPLICITLY.
