Market Manager Updates

Residential & Renewable Market Manager Update – Maria Grazul

- Honeywell has been preparing for the new incentives available through ARRA, including updating the website, and development of new applications. Home Performance and HVAC have launched in January with Energy Efficient Products expected to launch in April.
- Other program materials have also been updated with 2010 program information.
- Planning continues for the ACI Home Performance conference planned for March 4/5 in Atlantic City.
- A recent Community Partners event held at the Rutgers Ecoplex was attended by over 80 participants and resulted in five new enrollments.

Commercial and Industrial Market Manager Update – Richard Rinck
