2019 Energy Master Plan Stakeholder Process

- Four hearings have occurred; 1 more for September and 2 more are scheduled for October. The details are available on NJBPU's Energy Master Plan webpage. Responses to Staff Questions are due October 12.
- Board staff anticipates a "draft" EMP out in the winter with an opportunity to comment on the draft.
- Tentative schedule for issuance of a final EMP is June 2019.

Implementation of the Clean Energy Act of 2018

- Board staff anticipates a decision to be announced shortly on the interpretation of the Act with regard to the reduction in "SREC term" akaQualification Life from 15 to 10 years.
- At this time, aside from the Board's rule proposal published on August 6 and open for public comment through October 5th, there is no update on the closing of the SRP and plans for the opening of the new replacement program.
- Board staff will consider providing guidance regarding The Act's reference to SRP closure upon attainment of 5.1%.
- Board Staff expects to announce shortly how it plans to implement the requirement that certain projects be required to supply escrow.

Community Solar Pilot Program Update

- Questions from stakeholders and discussion were addressed by Ariane Benrey
- Proposed rules will be published in the NJ Register on October 1. The proposal will identify
 the process and schedule for submitting comments.

Consumer Protection Update and Request for Comments
