- A. Application Status EB & NC:

    - 289 approved
    - 7 are under review
    - Remaining are expired/rejected.

## Q: Is the Utility Tool required on CHP projects as well?

A: No, the CHP program does not have this requirement.

# Q: Is the orientation the only thing necessary to become approved? Is it too late to submit for partnership?

A: The orientation is the final step in the process. In order to become a partner, a company must first submit a Partnership Application (available on <a href="www.njcleanenergy.com">www.njcleanenergy.com</a>) and submit to the Market Manager for review. The deadline for this has already passed, but the next deadline is coming up 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2014.

## Q: Are the new CHP incentive tiered?

A: The incentives are what they were before. Only CHP projects over 1 MW have a tiered incentive. All others are a fixed \$/watt incentive.

Q: Sometimes we have modular CHP units that are built up to create a larger system size. Is the incentive based on total system size?

A: Yes, the incentive is based on total system size per project site.
