FORECASTS & MARKET NEWS:

SREC DEMAND: Compliance filing from entities subject to NJ's RPS rules for Reporting Year 2006 were due on September 1, 2006. **The requirement for NJ SRECs in reporting year 2006 (June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006) was 10,450 SRECs** based upon retail electric sales and the RPS percentage of 0.017% less the load served by 2003 BGS Auction winners granted an exemption from the solar percentages in the first year. **As of August 31, 2006, a total of 12,747 SRECs had been issued for Reporting Year 2006** (production from June 1, 2005 - May 31, 2006) to solar facilities that registered for the SREC program. 10,723 SRECs were retired and 163 Solar Alternative Compliance Payments were made by regulated entities toward compliance with RPS requirements in Reporting Year 2006.

The forecast demand for NJ SRECs in reporting year 2007 (June 1, 2006 through May 31, 2007) is 29,000 SRECs based upon estimated retail electric sales of 73,800,000 MWh and the RPS percentage of 0.0393%.

PJM GATS / Class I Markets: The PJM Environmental Information Services (PJM EIS) launched the Generation Attribute Tracking System (GATS) for the PJM Mid-Atlantic region in October 2005. The Generation Attribute Tracking System (GATS) provides information about how megawatt-hours of electricity were generated and is used to track compliance with renewable portfolio standards and other environmental disclosure requirements. The NJ RPS Class I requirement for Reporting Year 2006 was 833,750 RECs based upon retail electric sales and an RPS percentage of 0.983% for entities with a 0.17% solar requirement and 1.0% RPS requirement for load served by 2003 BGS Auction winners that were granted a solar exemption. As of August 31, 2006, 847,857 Class I RECs were retired and 19 Alternative Compliance Payments were paid by regulated entities toward compliance with Reporting Year 2006 (June 1, 2005 – May 31, 2006) requirements. In the June 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006 period, PJM GATS reported creating 901,533 Class I RECs eligible to meet NJ RPS requirements for Reporting Year 2007.
