

New Jersey's Clean Energy ProgramTM WARMAdvantage and COOLAdvantage HVAC Programs for the 2013-2014 Program Year

Dear Participating Contractor:

Thank you for your commitment to the New Jersey residential HVAC programs. This notice includes important changes for the **2014 program year** which begins **July 1st, 2013** and continues **through June 30th 2014**.

Purchases made prior to the date of the changes below will be processed according to the program guidelines and incentives in place at the time of purchase.

Hurricane Sandy enhanced incentives may also be available in addition to the incentives on qualifying equipment below. Refer to <u>NJCleanEnergy.com/SANDY</u> for eligibility and instructions to qualify.

Program Year 2013-2014 KEY PROGRAM CHANGES:

COOLAdvantage Program:

- Central A/C systems that are 17 SEER/13 EER statewide are eligible for a \$500 incentive for purchases on or after **July 1, 2013**. For customers whose homes have been damaged due to Hurricane Sandy, central A/C systems that are 16 SEER/13 EER remain eligible for a \$500 incentive for purchases on or after **October 29, 2012**.
- Ductless Mini-Split Units and Heat Pump efficiency criteria changes to 17 SEER/13 EER/8.5 HSPF for purchases made on or after <u>August</u> 1, 2013.
- For customers impacted by **Hurricane Sandy**, the enhanced **\$200** incentive per unit remains on qualifying heat pumps and ductless mini-split units in addition to the incentive payments shown on the following page and remains retroactive for purchases made on or after **October 29**, **2012**.

WARMAdvantage Program:

- Combination installations of a qualifying hydronic gas boiler or steam boiler (see table below) with a qualifying water heater are eligible for **\$900** for purchases made on or after **July 1, 2013.**
- Heat Pump Water Heaters that are ENERGY STAR are eligible for a \$500 incentive for purchases made on or after August 1, 2013.
- For customers impacted by **Hurricane Sandy**, the existing enhanced **\$200** incentive <u>per unit</u> remains on qualifying furnaces, boilers, and water heaters in addition to the incentive payments shown on the following page. This incentive remains active for purchases made on or after **October 29, 2012.**

State Energy Program (SEP) HVAC Program:

• The SEP Program for municipal and co-op electric, propane, and oil customers will mirror the HVAC incentive schedule and will continue through June 30, 2014 or until funds are exhausted. **Hurricane Sandy** enhanced incentives continue to apply to these customers as well.
