



# 2010 WARMAdvantage Rebate Application Instructions, Terms and Conditions For Oil and Propane Customers

FOR SYSTEMS PURCHASED ON OR AFTER FEBRUARY 1, 2010

Customer: Please read the program instructions, terms and conditions before completing the form on the reverse.



## A. CUSTOMERS – TO QUALIFY FOR YOUR REBATE, YOU MUST:

1. Purchase, install, and operate a high-efficiency furnace, boiler, and/or hot water heater in a residence that is currently supplied with oil or propane.
2. Replace an installation in an existing New Jersey home.
3. High-efficiency furnace, boiler and/or domestic hot water heater must meet the efficiency levels in the table below, based on the AHRI Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute Directory of Certified Product Performance. Conversion burners are not eligible.
4. Abide by the rules and rebate levels in effect at the date of purchase.
5. **Postmark the application within 60 days of purchase date.**

Gas Furnace	AFUE* 92% or greater, ENERGY STAR® qualified	\$300
Oil Furnace	AFUE 85% or greater ENERGY STAR qualified	\$300
Gas Boiler	AFUE 85% or greater ENERGY STAR qualified	\$300
Oil Boiler	AFUE 85% or greater ENERGY STAR qualified	\$300
Gas Storage Water Heater	EF* .62 or greater ENERGY STAR qualified	\$25
Gas Tankless Water Heater	EF .82 or greater ENERGY STAR qualified	\$300

2. If you are applying for more than one rebate, separate rebate forms are to be completed for each individual unit.

## C. IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Funding for this rebate program is provided through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Due to the federal source of funds, applicants will be subject to special ARRA terms and conditions as described in this document.
2. Due to the limited availability of funds, the program will terminate when funds are exhausted. Program termination will be posted on NJCleanEnergy.com
3. Applications or supporting documentation received after the program termination date will not be honored.
4. Program procedures, requirements and rebate levels are subject to change or cancellation without notice.
5. It is the responsibility of the customer to assure that all requirements for the rebate are met and that all required documentation is provided.
6. If the customer portion of the rebate is to be assigned to another party, the customer must authorize this by completing and signing section B of the application form.
7. Failure to provide any of the required information will prevent processing of your application.
8. Please allow up to 120 days from the date *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* receives **all required information** to process your rebate.
9. *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* reserves the right to inspect all installations in order to ensure compliance with all program requirements.
10. Incentives are available for the installation (retrofit) of qualified HVAC equipment in all existing residential buildings.
11. *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* provides no oversight or control over any contractor services related to this program. Responsibility for proper installation, as well as delivery and workmanship related to any equipment or services the customer procures, rests exclusively with the contractor selected by the customer. *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* assumes no responsibility for oversight of contractor services.
12. Only one rebate will be issued to each customer for each appliance type.
13. *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* audits its rebate programs as a protection against consumer and/or contractor fraud. Any attempt to defraud *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* will result in automatic rejection of the rebate application and possible legal action.
14. Installations must be completed in accordance with all laws, codes and other requirements applicable under federal, state, and local authority.
15. You are urged to seek appropriate consultation concerning both tax liabilities that might be associated with the receipt of the rebate and any Federal tax credits available.
16. Customers participating in other *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program* or *New Jersey Weatherization Assistance Programs* may not be eligible for rebates.
17. Installations of equipment in new homes are not eligible for incentives.
