



The Board Denies EDCs and RESA's Request for Extension of Energy Year 2017 (EY 17) Compliance deadline and approves an RPS Compliance Time Line with a Retail Sales Adjustment Procedure

At the July 26, 2017 Board Agenda meeting, the Board denied the EDCs and RESA's request for a 30 day extension to November 1, 2017 to submit their EY 17 RPS Annual compliance reports. The Annual report due date will remain **October 1, 2017**. The Board Order and other EY 17 Compliance documentation are attached.

At this meeting, the Board also approved the EY 17 RPS Compliance Time Line and a Retail Sales Adjustment procedure. TPS/BGS Providers have until the close of business ("COB") Tuesday, August 29th to review their "My RPS Compliance report" on PJM-EIS GATS (GATS) for consistency with their own EY 17 retail sales calculation. If there is a difference, they must request an adjustment to their retail sales reported in GATS with Staff. If the amount in the "My RPS Compliance report" is inaccurate, you **must** also report your final retail sales amount to OCE along with a **written explanation** for the difference. You must also enter your final retail sales number on the GATS "My RPS Compliance report" in the column entitled "**RPS Load**". Please submit sales adjustment requests with explanation to Ronald.jackson@bpu.nj.gov by COB **August 29, 2017**. If no sales adjustment request is sent to the OCE by this date, the August 1, 2017 retail sales number listed in the "My RPS Compliance Report" will be considered **final**. These final retail sales figures and compliance instructions are to be used to calculate **final RPS** obligations for individual TPS/BGS Providers compliance reports. Failure to comply with the RPS obligations based on final retail sales recorded in the GATS system will result in Staff pursuing enforcement penalties with the Board.
