

SmartStart Buildings Program: Food Service Equipment Incentives



Food service equipment incentives are available for the installation of energy efficient ovens, steamers, griddles, fryers, refrigeration equipment, ice machines, holding cabinets, and cleaning equipment. Both equipment replacement and new construction projects are eligible to apply. Incentive rates are pre-determined based on the size and efficiency of new equipment. Pre-approval is not required prior to installation however, applications must be submitted within 1 year of material purchase to remain eligible for the incentive. Projects in buildings located in Urban Enterprise Zones, Opportunity Zones, owned or operated by a municipality, or K-12 public school are eligible for double the incentive.

Electric convection oven	\$350/oven
Electric fryer	\$200/vat
Electric large vat fryer	\$200/vat
Electric griddle	\$300/griddle
Electric steam cooker	\$1,250/steamer

Natural Gas Cooking

Combination gas oven/steamer	\$750/oven
Gas convection oven	\$500/oven
Gas rack oven - single	\$1,000
Gas rack oven - double	\$2,000
Gas conveyor oven - small deck	\$500/deck
Gas conveyor oven - large deck	\$750/deck
Gas fryer	\$749/vat
Gas large vat fryer	\$500/vat
Gas griddle	\$125/griddle
Gas steam cooker	\$2,000/steamer

Holding

Full-size insulated cabinets	\$300/cabinet
Three-quarter size insulated cabinets	\$250/cabinet
Half-size insulated cabinets	\$200/cabinet

Cooling

Glass door refrigerators	\$75 - \$150/unit
Solid door refrigerators	\$50 - \$200/unit
Glass door freezers	\$200 - \$1,000/unit
Solid door freezers	\$100 - \$600/unit
Ice machines	\$50 - \$500/unit

Cleaning

Dishwashers	\$400 - \$1,500/unit

Complete and submit the Food Service Equipment incentive application found at NJCleanEnergy.com/FOOD.
Pre-approval is not required for Food Service Equipment Applications must be submitted within 1 year of material purchase to remain eligible for the incentive.

Receive an email confirmation that your project has been received.

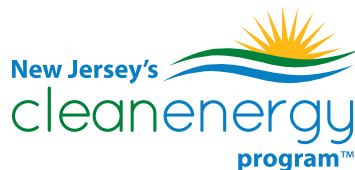
If your project meets all eligibility requirements, your application will be approved.

Receive an application approval letter.

If your project is already complete, please include the material and labor invoice, Tax Clearance for customer and W9, ST-4, ST-5 for payee.

Receive your incentive

All projects are subject to a post-inspection to confirm equipment installation prior to incentive payment.
