## **CSI Registration Certification Form**

CSI Program Registration Certification Form: Requirements, Instructions, Terms and Conditions

Before completing this CSI Registration Certification Form, please carefully read all the information in Sections A, B, C, and D below.

#### **A. Qualification Requirements**

- 1. The proposed system must be interconnected with the distribution or transmission system owned or operated by a New Jersey public utility or local government unit serving New Jersey.
- 2. The system must be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, include an owner's manual and warranty documentation and comply with the CSI installation requirements.
- 3. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 14:8-11.10, eligible facilities will only be allowed to register in CSI upon award of bid. CSI eligible facilities include new net metered non-residential solar facilities greater than 5 MW (dc), qualifying grid supply solar facilities and grid supply solar facilities paired with storage.
- 4. The equipment used in a CSI eligible solar facility must be new, that is, none of the equipment may have been used prior to the installation of the CSI eligible solar facility.

### B. Instructions for Completing the CSI Program Registration Certification Form

- 1. Complete all of sections A through D of the CSI Program Registration Certification Form. All information is necessary for processing an initial Registration package. The CSI Program Registration Certification Form is required to be uploaded in the CSI online portal.
- 2. All requested signatures on the CSI Registration Certification Form are required. All electronic signatures require a Certificate of Completion or signature verification sheet to be attached to the document when uploaded.
- 3. All information that is entered on this form must be consistent with the information entered in the CSI online portal and all other registration documents.

### **C. Important Terms and Conditions**

- 1. The "<u>Registrant</u>" is defined to be the entity that registers for the CSI Program.
- 2. The CSI Program Registration Manager, TRC is the organization that was contracted by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (NJBPU) to administer the CSI Program.
- 3. The NJBPU reserves the right to modify the CSI Program. CSI Program procedures are subject to change without notice. Projects conditionally accepted into the CSI will be honored under the terms stated in the CSI conditional acceptance letter.
- 4. The registration received date will be established based upon the date that all required registration documents are uploaded to the CSI portal and the project status is changed to CSI Registration Received.
- 5. Solar facilities receiving incentives that are 1 MW dc or larger in size are subject to the Prevailing Wage Act N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25.
- 6. If selected, the Premise Contact must agree to an on-site inspection of their installed solar electric system by an CSI Program inspector. The Primary Contact must agree to allow the CSI Program to verify the facility's energy production for the life of the system.
- 7. All solar installations must comply with the host Electric Distribution Company's interconnection requirements consistent with N.J.A.C. 14:8-5 which are available online (or equivalent requirements of a municipal electric utility); these include operation/ disconnection procedures, liability/ indemnity and insurance requirements according to the size of the project. For information on interconnection, please see our web site at NJCleanEnergy.com or contact your Electric Distribution Company (EDC).
- 8. The solar installation must be performed by a NJ licensed electrical contractor and the registrant must provide the company name, contact information, license number and expiration date in the online portal. N.J.S.A. 45:5A-2(d) states that solar PV systems are by definition electrical work and requires any person engaged in installing, erecting, or repairing such equipment to be an electrical contractor as defined in the Act.
- 9. Portable systems are not eligible to participate in the CSI Program.
- 10. All CSI-eligible facilities, other than those located on the built environment, must with the requirements for soil erosion and sediment control in accordance with the N.J. Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Act (N.J.S.A. 4:24-39 et seq.) and implementing Rules at N.J.A.C. 2:90-1.0 et seq.
- 11. CSI-eligible facilities, other than those mounted on the built environment, be required to comply with NJDEP's "Standards for the use of Pollinator-friendly Native Plant Species and Seed Mixes in Grid Supply and Select Net Metered Solar Facilities" ("Pollinator Standards"). CSI-eligible facilities that meet the requirements for qualification in the Contaminated Sites and Landfills tranche of the CSI Program would be exempted from mandatory compliance with the Pollinator Standards because landfill closure and contamination mitigation requirements may impose other and potentially conflicting requirements.
- 12. CSI-eligible facilities shall comply with NJDEP's Stormwater Management Rules pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:8
- 13. All CSI-eligible facilities located on covered agricultural lands, other than those mounted on the built environment, shall prepare a plan, etc. (N.J.A.C. 14:8-12.8(g)
- 14. For solar facilities that were awarded paired with electric storage, N.J.A.C. 14:8-11.6(k) the adder is provided for energy produced by the solar system. The storage adder may be subject to revocation, and the value of the SREC-II of the associated solar facility adjusted to compensate for over payment of any SREC-II adders, if Board staff determines that there is evidence lacking that the qualified storage facility remains operational.
- 15. All installations must comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, permit requirements and regulations.
- 16. Aggregated information will be used in reports and evaluations, and the geographic location may be used to update GIS mapping
- 17. Information may be subject to the Open Public Records Act requirements.
- 18. A contract is required to be submitted between the primary installer or third party and the bidder or customer on record. One year after receiving conditional registration in the CSI Program.
