 - i. Revision to incentive logic for High Energy Intensity projects. Error identified when project is identified as High EUI, but still projects 15%+ savings.
 - ii. Revision to Measure Simulation tab. Error identified for TRACE projects Annual Energy Usage (kWh) column refers to column E of the 'Results from Trace' tab in all rows. So, it would look as though no electric savings were present for any measure.

- v. Sub-consultants must CC partner of record on all email correspondence.
- vi. For multi-building submittals we will be reaching out to the partner following application approval to advise on how best proceed with ERP submittals.
