3. Multifamily Program Update:

[From NJBPU]: "In light of the Clean Energy Act passed in May of 2018, we are currently undergoing a transition of New Jersey's energy efficiency programs. Staff issued a straw proposal on March 20, 2020 that recommended the Multifamily Program be transition to the utilities for administration. In light of the recommendations and the pending transition, the Multifamily program will likely not be available as a standalone program for the time being. However, multifamily projects are eligible in many of New Jersey's Clean Energy Program's existing program portfolio."
