1. Documents and Forms:

- a. P4P Existing Buildings updates to ERP Tables and Savings Verification Tool. *Refer to webinar.*
 - i. ERP Tables v5.1 Notable Changes:
 - 1. Integrated Multifamily Alternative Approach In-Unit kWh Calculator
 - 2. Functionality added to calculate and track in-unit kWh baseline load and measure savings from multifamily tenants.
 - 3. QC check added for savings cap on controls and/or high-uncertainty measure savings
 - ii. SVT v1.16 Notable Changes:
 - 1. Format updated to align with ERP updates above
 - 2. Site-to-source ratios updated to align with ERP released in July
 - 3. Combined calculations for standard projects and high-energy intensity projects into single SVT tool.

2. Other News:

- a. NJ Dept. of Community Affairs adopted new codes, including energy subcode, on September 3rd, 2019 with a 6-month grace period.

 - ii. No action to programs at this time, but changes are expected for FY21 (July 1, 2020) pending review and discussion with BPU.

 - i. All new submittals (applications, ERPs RevO, Installations RevO, etc.) must be submitted to the <u>P4P@njcleanenergy.com</u> email
 - This also includes submittals uploaded to FTP or TRCNET. Please send an email to <u>P4P@njcleanenergy.com</u> notifying us of the upload and/or providing FTP access
 - iii. All emails must contain Application Number (except new applications), Project Name, and Revision Number in the subject line.
 - iv. Resubmittals/revisions may be emailed directly to your reviewer but should CC P4P@njcleanenergy.com in the event a reviewer is out of the office, etc.
 - v. Sub-consultants must CC partner of record on all email correspondence.
