

FOOD SERVICE EQUIPMENT INCENTIVES



Get the Recipe for Money-Saving Solutions!

Here's some food for thought: per square foot, restaurants use five to seven times the energy of other commercial facilities. You can make a huge impact on your facility's energy use and profitability with incentives available through New Jersey's Clean Energy Program, an easy and effective way to improve your bottom line. Incentives from the SmartStart Buildings Program are available for the following kitchen equipment:

Electric Cooking

Combination electric oven/steamer	\$1,000/oven
Convection oven	\$350/oven
Fryer	\$200/vat
Large vat fryer	\$200/vat
Griddle	\$300/griddle
Steam cooker	\$1,250/steamer

Holding

Full-size insulated cabinets	\$300/cabinet
Three-quarter-size insulated cabinets	\$250/cabinet
Half-size insulated cabinets	\$200/cabinet

Natural Gas Cooking

Combination gas oven/steamer	\$750/oven
Convection oven	\$500/oven
Rack oven - single	\$1,000
Rack oven - double	\$2,000
Conveyor oven - small deck	\$500/deck
Conveyor oven - large deck	\$750/deck
Fryer	\$749/vat
Large vat fryer	\$500/vat
Griddle	\$125 griddle
Steam cooker	\$2,000/steamer

Cooling & Cleaning

Glass door refrigerators	\$75-\$150/unit
Solid door refrigerators	\$50-\$200/unit
Glass door freezers	\$200-\$1,000/unit
Solid door freezers	\$100-\$600/unit
Ice machines	\$50-\$500/unit
Dishwashers	\$400-\$1,500/unit

Food Service projects located in Urban Enterprise Zones or Opportunity Zones, in buildings owned or operated by a local government, K-12 public schools, or designated as affordable housing may be eligible for double the incentives up to program caps.

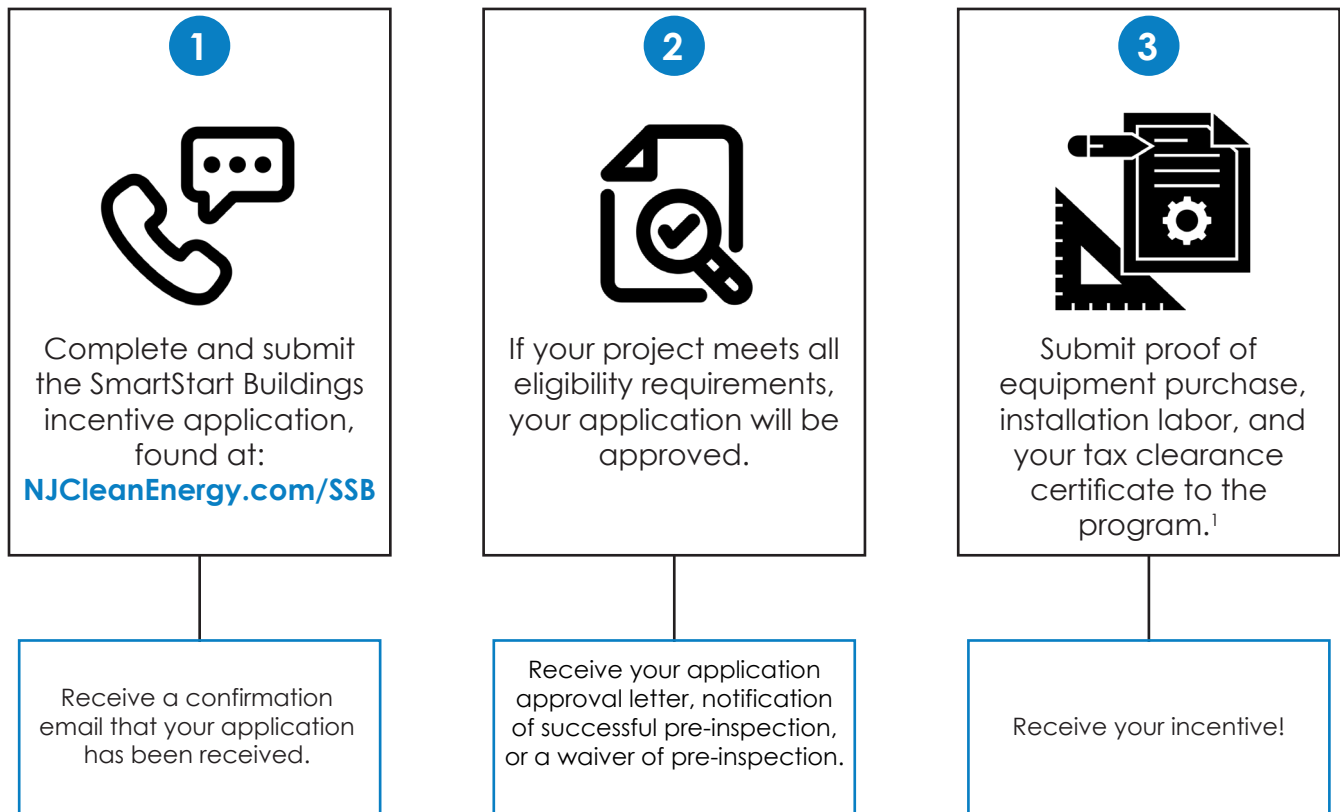
