## Dear Homeowner(s):

Thank you for your interest in the *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program*<sup>TM</sup> *Home Performance with ENERGY STAR*<sup>®</sup> program. This program can help you achieve significant energy savings, reduce your monthly bills, and provide you with a more comfortable home.

Because the program looks to improve the energy efficiency of your *whole* house, incentive levels increase as your energy savings increase. Achieving 25% total energy savings will qualify you for the maximum incentive level available.

Following are the incentive levels for all new program applications submitted on or after July 29, 2010:

- o For projects with total estimated energy savings between 5% and 25%, there is a maximum cash rebate of \$1,300 or low interest loan at 5.99%.
- o For projects with total estimated energy savings of 25% or more, there is a maximum cash rebate of \$3,000 and a 0% interest loan.

If you choose to expand your project so that you achieve total estimated energy savings of 25% or more, your contractor will be required to submit a revised work scope proposal for approval, and you may need to sign a new contract to reflect the expanded project. You will then be able to begin work.
