

NJCEP Sampling Procedures

New Jersey Clean Energy Program Raters:

The following items are required to participate in the New Jersey Clean Energy Program if you are using **RESNET Sampling Standards** from Chapter 6

- 1. Rater will send the Program Administrator the Provider's ID and whether they are a Sampling Provider. Sampling Provider will send the Program Administrator their Operation Policies and Procedures for Sampling.
- 2. Each Sample Set will list which stage of construction the set is undergoing; i.e. Pre-drywall or Final.
- 3. When identified, we require the number and ID of individual units within a Sample Set. Each sample set will be completed within a 30 day period, and dates of each inspection will be included in the Sample Set information.
- 4. The first 7 consecutive, complete test/inspection results will be submitted to the Program as soon as the inspection reports are completed. For a newly started subdivision, the 3 consecutive complete test/inspection results will also be submitted to the Program at RNCNJCEP@NJCleanEnergy.com subject line to state "Sample Set for [Project Name and Address]."
- 5. The Program will be notified of any failures in the subsequent Sampling Set, and the results of testing/inspections of the two additional tests from the Sampled Set as soon as these failures occur. Information about any and all further failures will also be sent to the Program.
- 6. Program Administrator reserves the right to notify Rater's Provider and/or RESNET if any failure occurs during our routine QA process
- 7. Root Cause Analysis report on failures shall be sent to the Program.
- 8. Program reserves the right to inspect or test any home in the Sample Set, regardless if the unit has been inspected or tested.
